



IMPECS-POPL Workshop on Emerging Research & Development Trends in Programming Languages (WEPL) co-located with 42nd ACM SIGPLAN-SIGACT Symposium on Principles of Programming Languages (POPL 2015)

The goal of WEPL 2015 (<http://events.csa.iisc.ernet.in/WEPL/>) is to provide a setting in which people working in the area of programming languages have an opportunity to present and discuss their work with other researchers of this community. The workshop aims to provide students and faculties with useful feedback on their work and to facilitate networking within the programming language community. WEPL will consist of invited talks by renowned academicians and industrial researchers, a panel discussion, as well as a poster session. We call upon 3rd and 4th year UG engineering students, Masters and PhD students, as well as faculty members, to submit poster proposals and to present their posters at WEPL. We also welcome people who do not submit poster proposals to register for WEPL and to attend it. WEPL will take place on January 18th 2015, in the TIFR campus in Mumbai.

Call for poster proposal submissions

The technical scope of the workshop is in all aspects of programming languages and programming systems. Both theoretical and experimental proposals are welcome, on topics ranging from formal frameworks to experience reports, software tools. The program committee will select poster proposals for presentation at WEPL using the following criteria:

- Quality and content of the proposal
- Clarity of definition of the problem being addressed
- Solution approach, and the evaluation and results
- Relevance to the technical scope mentioned above

Submission Format

Submissions should be of at most 2 pages describing the work that you want to present in your WEPL poster. The proposals must be prepared as per SIGPLAN (<http://www.sigplan.org/Resources/Author>) guidelines and should cover:

- The problem that you are working on with justification of its importance
- Discussion on related and prior work
- A sketch of the proposed approach or solution
- The expected contributions of this work
- The evaluation setup and results obtained
